About Answerland

Answerland ([answerland.org](https://www.answerland.org)) is a statewide collaborative information service that connects Oregon residents with library information professionals 24/7.

It is operated by the State Library of Oregon, and supported with Library Services and Technology Act (LSTA) funds from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) as well as the contributions of staff at partner libraries. Leadership for the program is bolstered by an advisory committee comprised of information professionals from around Oregon.

Activities

Advisory Committee

New Software

In May 2019 it was announced that Answerland's current software vendor (OCLC) had entered into an agreement to sell all QuestionPoint subscriptions to a new company (Springshare). This announcement means Answerland was to move to a new software platform (LibAnswers). The migration was successfully completed in May 2020.

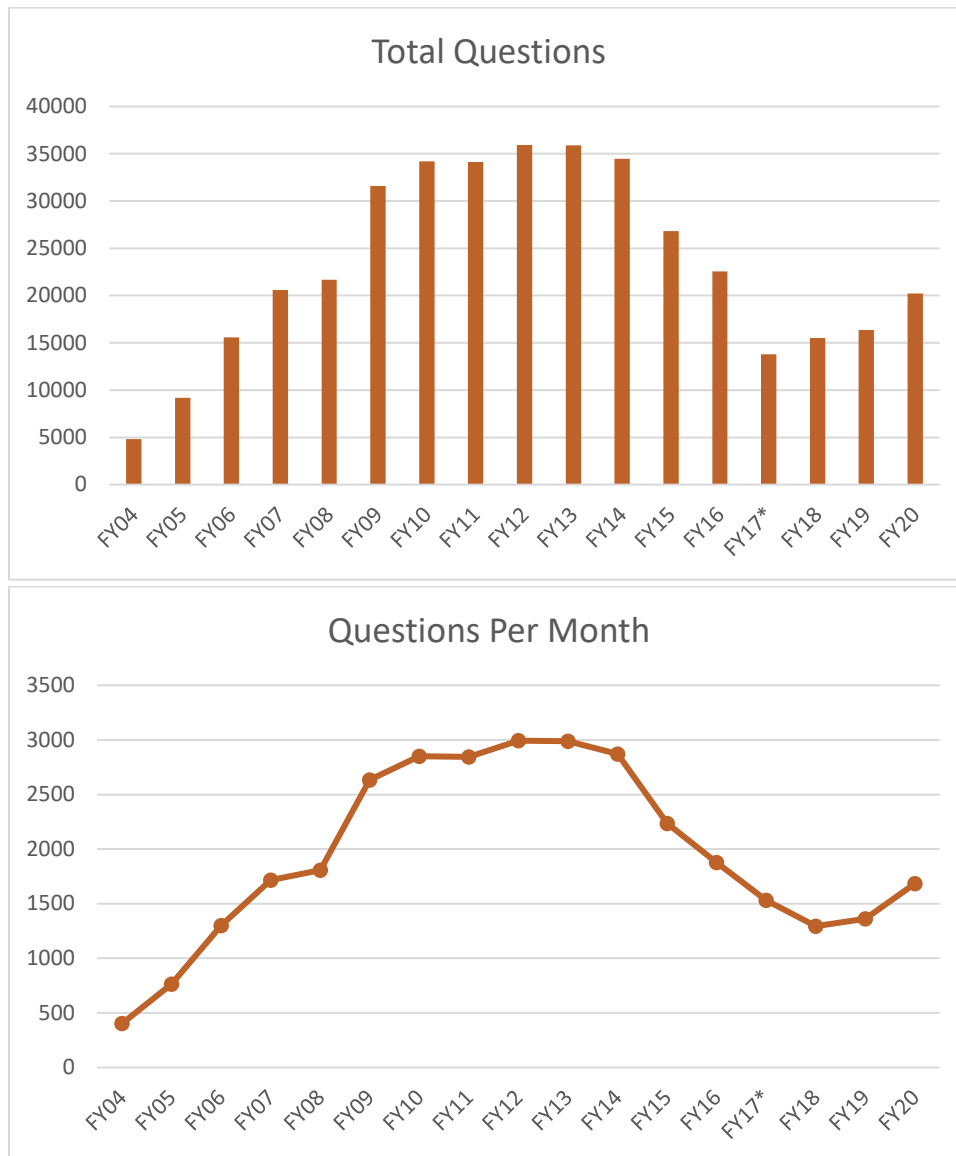
Answerland en Español

At the start of the pandemic, libraries identified a growing need for a Spanish-language information service. In response, Answerland en Español was born. Now patrons can go to [answerland.org](https://www.answerland.org) and chat with a Spanish speaking librarian. This service started in mid-April and received over 70 patron questions. It is supported by bilingual library staff at Oregon libraries (who also helped translate web & promotional content) as well as the LibAnswers Cooperativa en Español.



Usage

The number of questions from patrons increased 24% from the previous year, and the questions per month similarly rose. Possible factors include increased accessibility due to the new software, addition of a new service (Answerland en Español), and rise in patron use of virtual services during the COVID-19 pandemic.

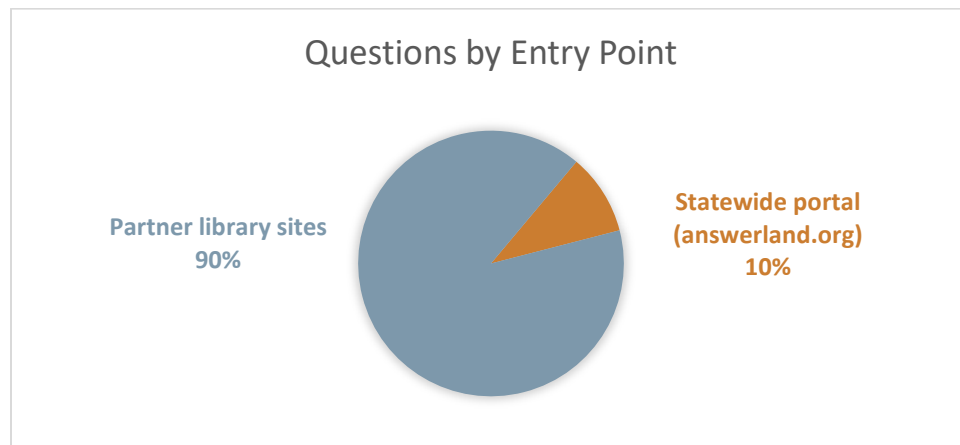


* Service down for 3 months in FY17 due to software transition



How patrons get to Answerland

Patrons can get to Answerland through the statewide portal (answerland.org) – which is linked from numerous websites, such as OSLIS, and library websites – as well as through local options set up by partner libraries. While the answerland.org site only gets a small portion the overall Answerland traffic, having a statewide portal is vital to serving under- and unserved populations, including K-12.



Staffing

There were over 250 librarians contributing over 65 hours per week of their time to Answerland. Answerland librarians answer questions from 24/7 Reference Cooperative as well as from Oregon patrons.

Volunteers

Answerland had 10 volunteers staffing the statewide portal. Together they staffed chat approximately 400 hours and responded to over 1,000 patron questions.

Partner Libraries

Answerland had 34 partner libraries – 17 academic libraries, 12 public libraries, and 5 special libraries. 20 partner libraries were full partners, which means their staff participate in the live chat service. The rest of the partner libraries were referral partners, which means their staff respond to questions sent to them via email. The partner libraries responded to over 14,000 questions this year.
